Wine and Music Extravaganza

The next chapter event will be a wine and music extravaganza featuring the Idaho-Washington Concert Chorale. This event presents an excellent opportunity to sample fine wines to the accompaniment of live chorale music. It will take place on Sunday, March 2, 3:00pm at St. James Episcopal Church, 1410 NE Stadium Way in Pullman. Each participant will choose up to 10 tastes from an array of 20 expertly selected white and red wines. The focus will be on comparison of Old World wines, designated by geography, with New World wines named varietally. Members of the Idaho-Washington Concert Chorale will sing Broadway and Opera songs to entertain the guests, and members of the Palouse Enological Society will discuss the wines. Hearty hors d'oeuvres will be provided.
