This dinner will feature a four course meal of South American food carefully paired with South American wines. Courses will include appetizers from Venezuela, Colombia and Ecuador, a soup from Chile, entrees from Brazil and Argentina, and a Colombian dessert. We will explore a range of tastes and textures, while experiencing traditional dishes from these diverse countries. In addition, South America is recognized for producing wines of excellent value, as well as being increasingly noted for excellent quality. Argentina is one of the top wine-producing (and consuming) countries in the world, and Chile continues to impress the critics with some of their newest wines, including their signature grape, Carmenere. We will drink wines from these two countries and taste several varietals, including a sparkling wine, Pinot Noir, Merlot, and Cabernet/ Carmenere.
