What: Cabernet Franc Around the World

Please join us in exploring the Cabernet Franc grape as it is grown throughout the world. It is known as the best red grape of the Loire Valley of France. It is also a much used but minor component of many a red Bordeaux. It is the most planted grape in the vineyards of Cheval Blanc. As a vine varietal the Cabernet Franc predates its more famous offspring the Cabernet Sauvignon. It has been grown in Northern Italy for over 100 years.

We will taste wines from 4 appellations in the Loire Valley: Chinon, Bourgueil, St-Nicolas-de-Bourgueil, and the rare Saumur Champigny. Then the next 2 flights will be conducted blind. In each of these flights will be an example from Italy, USA, and the Southern Hemisphere. Bread and cheese will accompany the tasting.
