However, before the Pinot craze hit, early settlers in the Willamette Valley recognized the potential for Riesling in the region. We will explore wines made from these "old vine" Rieslings in addition to examples of light-bodied or "feminine"-styled Pinot Noir and full-bodied or "masculine"-styled Pinot Noir. Served with the wines will be cheeses from Oregon and Hazelnuts harvested from an organic farm in Monmouth, Oregon. The wine lineup includes:
