Brunello di Montalcina has a long history of excellent wines, and in 1980 it was among the four wines awarded the first *Denomination di Orgine Controllata e Garantita* (DOCG) designation. It retains its position as one of the most highly regarded Italian wines, and the 2010 vintage was epic by all accounts. In 2015, we purchased a tasting that represents the diverse growing regions of the DOCG and our monitoring over the last few years indicate that these are just entering their peak drinking window. We'll serve Bruschetta with a couple Tuscan whites to start the evening and river chanterelle polenta, green beans with pasta, and braised lamb shoulder with gnocchi with the three Brunello flights.
