Most people are quite familiar with pinot noir from Oregon, California and Burgundy, but some wonderful pinots are also produced in the Southern Hemisphere. In this tasting we will focus on highly-rated pinots from Chile, Argentina, Tasmania (Australia) and New Zealand. This tasting is a unique opportunity to taste some rare, hard to get low production pinots from Tasmania and New Zealand since they were transported back to the US in a board member's suitcase. The tasting will feature 3 flights of wine, all from the 2018 Vintage. Within each flight we will be comparing one wine from each country:

Opener: Arras Blanc de Blancs sparkling from Bay of Fires Winery, Tasmania (yes, this is a chardonnay, but a real treat)

Flight 1

Chile: Albamar, Casablanca Valley Argentina: Verum, Patagonia

New Zealand: Matt Connell Rendition, Central Otago

Tasmania: Stefano Lubiana "Primavera"

Flight 2

Chile: Montsecano "Refugio", Casablanca Valley Argentina: Domaine Bousquet, UCO Valley New Zealand: Felton Road Block 5, Central Otago

Tasmania: Giant Steps, Nocton Vineyard

Flight 3

Chile: Bodega Chacra "Cincuenta y Cinco" Patagonia

Argentina: Luca, Mendoza

New Zealand: TeMATA Estate Alma, Central Otago

Tasmania: Tolpuddle Vineyard

Each flight will be enhanced by accompanying food: Flight 1 mushroom soup, Flight 2 with smoked salmon, and Flight 3 with a duck sausage stew with a fresh salad.
