Riesling is one of the most versatile white grapes, and like Pinot Noir, is exceptionally good at expressing terroir. Please join us for our Rieslings Around the World tasting on Sunday, August 16 at 4:00 p.m. in the Crosslers' backyard, where we will embark upon an adventure to discover how terroir influences and changes wines made from Riesling grapes and how styles differ between where the grapes are grown, and by whom the wines are made.

Our opening pour will feature a sparkling Riesling from New York's Finger Lakes region. The first flight will take us to Australia, New Zealand, and Austria where we can experience the wines from different hemispheres while also providing a bit of a comparison and contrast between the Old World and New World. Flight two will focus on Rieslings in the United States: Washington state, Oregon, and New York. Our third flight will take us back to the Old World, where we will experience Rieslings from the France's Alsace region, the Mosel and Nahe regions of Germany, and from Italy's Piedmont region. In closing, an Auslese from Germany will be served, accompanied by blue cheese and apple slices for dessert. As always, a delicious offering of foods will be prepared to accompany the wine flights.

This event will take place in Rob & Crystal Crossler's backyard at 256 NW Sunrise Drive in Pullman. The area will be shaded at the time of the tasting, so please plan to dress accordingly. Please bring your own table setting: plate, bowls, and silverware. Please note that there are two soups planned, so please bring an extra bowl if you do not want to mix flavors. The cost is \$50/person. We look forward to seeing you there!
